Community Grant Guidelines

Overview

- Community Grants range from a minimum of \$250 to the maximum grant of \$5,000.
- Individuals must submit an application to be considered for funding.
 Application may be obtained from our website or from a Three Angels Board member.
- The 2019 grant cycle begins January 1, 2019 and the application deadline is Dec. 31, 2019. Applications may be submitted at any time during this funding cycle.
- Individuals may only submit one application per funding cycle.

Eligibility Checklist

- Individuals applying must meet the following criteria:
 - o Individuals must exhibit a financial need
 - o Individuals must have a cancer diagnosis.
- Individuals must have a connection to the Aquidneck Island community:
 - This includes individuals who work on Aquidneck Island, live on Aquidneck Island, go to school on Aquidneck Island, or formerly lived on Aquidneck Island.

Selection Process

 The Three Angels Fund Board of Directors will review the application and make funding decisions on all submitted requests during their

- scheduled meetings. Meetings are held once every 60 days Jan-April and monthly May-December.
- Individuals will be notified of any decision via e-mail or phone. All funding decisions are final.
- If an individual is approved, grant checks will be mailed directly to the recipient's address listed in the grant application or to the company designated by the recipient to receive the funds. Please allow two to four weeks for delivery.

All grant applications are made subject to the Three Angels Fund Board of Directors' review. The Three Angels Fund reserves the right to decline funding to any organization based on review of the application.
